### **Chair of CARE International Supervisory Board**



Madame Louise Fréchette was elected Chair of the new CARE International Supervisory Board in June 2016. She joined the CARE Canada Board in 2007 and was elected its Chair in 2011. From 1998 to 2006, Madame Fréchette was Deputy Secretary General of the United Nations. Prior to this, she pursued a career in the Public Service of Canada, serving notably as Ambassador to Argentina and Uruguay (1985-1988), Ambassador and Permanent Representative to the

United Nations (1992-1994), Associate Deputy Minister of Finance (1995) and Deputy Minister of National Defence (1995-1998). She is a member of the Board of Directors of Essilor International. She is also a member of the Global Leadership Foundation and of the Advisory Board to the Institute for the Study of International Development, McGill University. Madame Fréchette is an Officer of the Order of Canada. She has a degree in History from the University of Montreal and a Certificate in Economy from the College of Europe in Bruges, Belgium.
