The CARE Approach



FY16



64% of all projects/initiatives engaged in **advocacy**, of which 19% did intensive advocacy and 45% did moderate advocacy.



57% of all projects/initiatives tested new ways for fighting poverty, of which 27% measured the results of the innovation.



57% of all projects/initiatives took tested and effective solutions to scale, linking and working with strategic alliances.

FY17
